

The panoramic yurt allows you to contemplate the breathtaking scenery while enjoying the peaceful surroundings.

What is in the yurt

- ≈ A wood-burning stove, firewood and an axe;
- ≈ A twin over double bunk bed and a futon;
- ≈ An extra double mattress;
- ≈ Basic dishware for 6 people and a washtub;
- ≈ A pot to melt snow (winter);
- ≈ A Camping stove (Coleman propane cylinders not included).

What you must bring

- ≈ Water (minimum 4L per 2 people per day)**;
- ≈ Matches, firelighter and newspapers;
- ≈ Toilet paper, rag, trash bag;
- ≈ Dish cloths, dish soap and a scrubbing sponge;
- ≈ Bedding or warm sleeping bags, pillows;
- ≈ Warm clothes (winter);
- ≈ Coleman propane cylinders;
- ≈ You are responsible for your lighting (If you bring candles, also bring something to put under them).

What is near the yurt

- ≈ Two benches and a barrel for an outdoor fire;
- ≈ A dry toilet;
- ≈ A wood shelter;
- ≈ A relaxing forest setting.

The panoramic yurt is perched on a rock formation and offers a magnificent view of the surrounding area. You can get to the yurt from the parking lot, located near a washroom and a shower. It is a 15 minutes uphill walk (60 metres high) to reach the yurt.

Yurt fees*

High season...... \$105/night Low season...... \$75/night

Accepted payment methods are cash, debit, Visa and MasterCard.

* The trail fees for 4 people are included for the duration of the stay. Applicable taxes are not included.

** It is possible to refill your water in the washroom located behind the Desjardins cabin (in the parking lot).

The water there is drinkable.
